

Moving the Search to a Section



Looking to move your Search field into a Section on select pages?

To do this, you'll need to add some custom JavaScript, as well as a bit of custom CSS.

(See [Add CSS and JavaScript](#) for more on adding custom files with the Brand Designer.)

Use the Section Designer to add **search-custom** as a class to your desired section.



2. Add JavaScript to move the search to that section on your page:

- Add the following to a script file in your brand:

• Example search-custom.js

```
AJS.toInit( function ($) {  
  $(".search-custom").append($("#search"));  
  $(".search-custom").parents(".zen-column").addClass("overflow-visible");  
});
```



Want to include other content in your section but have the search stay at the top? Just change the word **"append"** to **"prepend"** in the script above.

3. Add CSS to style the moved Search:

- Add the following to a CSS file in your brand, adjusting the **width** settings to what makes sense for your placement.

Example search-custom.css

```
/*Custom Search*/
.search-custom #search {
  position: relative;
  float: none;
  top: 0;
  left: 0;
  width: 200px;
  padding: 6px;
  margin: 0 auto !important;
}
.zen-column.overflow-visible,
.zen-bin.search-custom {
  overflow: visible;
  *overflow: visible;
}
.search-custom ol li {
  list-style-type: none;
  padding-right: 12px;
}
.search-custom #search .quick-nav-drop-down {
  position: relative;
  top: 8px;
  left: 0px;
}
.search-custom #search #quick-search-query {
  border: none;
  width: 200px;
}
```

Then Apply your brand changes, and your search field should appear in the desired section.
