

# Brand Selection By Group Membership

Normally Zen Brands are set globally or per space. But you can configure Zen Foundation to override the normal brand based on the logged in user's group membership.

To do this:

1. In the **zen** folder of your Confluence home (data) directory, create a file called **group-brand.properties**.
2. Add one line per group to the file of the form group-name=brand. For example:

## **group-brand.properties**

```
customers=corporate  
employees=intranet
```

would cause users who are members of the **customers** group to see your **corporate** brand, while users in the **employees** group would see the **intranet** brand. Normal global and space-level brand settings would continue to determine the brand seen by users that have neither group membership.

You don't need to restart Confluence after creating or modifying this file. However, depending on the browser, users might need to clear their browser cache to see the change take effect.
